

## How to Configure Your Laptop to Connect to the MMC Internet using Windows XP

Maine Medical Center provides a connection to the Internet over an in-house wireless network. We offer the Internet for the convenience of our patients and their families at no charge. To configure your laptop to connect to MMC's wireless network, you must perform the following steps.

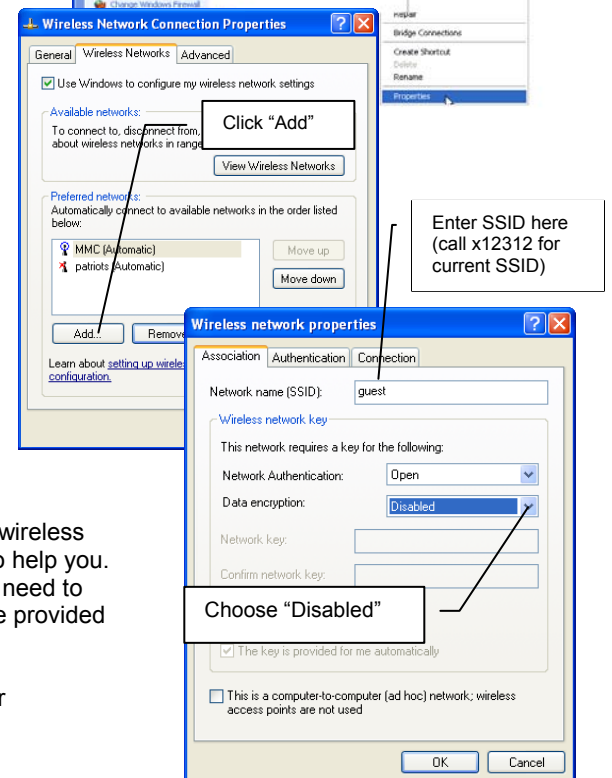
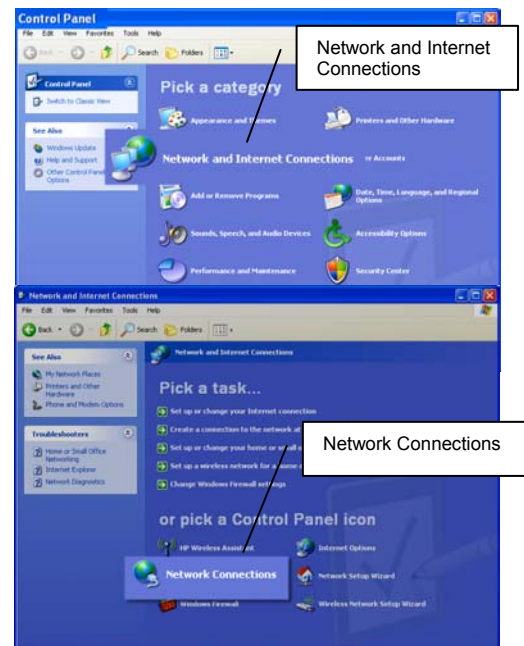
### To configure your laptop using Windows XP:

1. Power up your laptop and wait until the main Windows screen appears
2. Click <Start> → <Control Panel>
3. Click on <Network and Internet Connections>
4. Look for the <Wireless Network Connection> icon in the Network Connections Window
5. Right click on the <Wireless Connection> icon and left click (select) <Properties>
6. In the 'Wireless Network Connection Properties' Window, click on the 'Wireless Networks' tab at the top of the window
7. Left click on the 'Add' button in the lower third of the screen
8. In the 'Association' tab (default) that appears, note the Network Name [SSID]: box. You will need to enter the current MMC SSID in this field to configure your laptop. To obtain the current SSID, call x12312 from your room telephone. A voice message will provide you the current MMC SSID. Once you have the ID, hang up the phone and enter the ID in the SSID field. Please note that this ID is case sensitive. Enter it just the way the voice message prompts you to enter it.
9. In the 'Data encryption field' on this same screen, select 'disabled'
10. Click the OK button
11. Click the OK button again

The laptop should now connect to the Internet over MMCs wireless network.

Please remember that when you take your laptop back home with you, you may need to reconfigure it to work in your home environment. ## How to Configure Your Apple iBook to Connect to the MMC Internet using MAC OS X

### To configure your iBook using MAC OS X:

12. Power up your iBook and wait until the main OS screen appears
13. Click into the <System Preferences> icon
14. Click on <Network>
15. Click on the <AirPort> entry in the list and then click the Configure Button
16. Click on the "+" (plus) button under the list of available networks (which may be empty)
17. In the window that appears, note the Network Name box. You will need to enter the current MMC SSID in this field to configure your iBook. To obtain the current SSID, call x12312 from your room telephone. A voice message will provide you the current MMC SSID. Once you have the ID, hang up the phone and enter the ID in the Network Name field. Please note that this ID is case sensitive. Enter it just the way the voice message prompts you to enter it.
18. In the 'Wireless Security' box on this same screen, select 'None' from the drop down menu.
19. Click the OK button
20. Click the Apply Now button

The iBook should now connect to the Internet over MMC's wireless network.
